Mastectomy and Reconstruction at the Same Time

Your shoulder might become stiff and painful after breast surgery or removal of the lymph nodes. Your nurse or a physiotherapist will show you exercises to do after your operation to help improve movement in the shoulder. A swollen arm or hand You might have some slight swelling in your arm or hand after your operation.

Women who have reconstruction months or years after a mastectomy may go through a period of emotional adjustment once they've had their breast reconstructed. Just as it takes time to get used to the loss of a breast, it takes time to start thinking of the reconstructed breast as your own.

My Mastectomy Permanently Changed My Ability to Work Out ...

Right after the surgery you will probably feel weak, and you may feel sore for 2 to 3 days. You may have a pulling or stretching sensation near or under your arm. You may also have itching, tingling, and throbbing in the area. This will get better in a few days.

Mastectomy: What to Expect at Home

The amount of reconstruction will depend on the mastectomy and the width, size, and location of the removed tumor. This means that recovery looks very different. For at least 2 to 3 weeks, recovery patients experience soreness, swelling, and bruising.
