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In the 2012 fiscal-year version of ICD-9-CM, the code range for Chapter 19 is 800-999, a grouping that consists of 2,587 codes. Compare this to the same year's version of ICD-10-CM, where Chapter 19's code range is S00-T98, a grouping that consists of 39,869 codes.

N60.19 is a billable/specific ICD-10-CM code that can be used to indicate a diagnosis for reimbursement purposes. The 2021 edition of ICD-10-CM N60.19 became effective on October 1,

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2020. This is the American ICD-10-CM version of N60.19 - other international versions of ICD-10 N60.19 may differ.

ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting ... Most categories in chapter 19 have a 7th character requirement for each applicable code. Most categories in this chapter have three 7th character values (with the exception of fractures): A, initial encounter, D,

ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting ...

The 7th character represents the type of encounter, or phase of treatment; this could be an initial encounter, a subsequent encounter, or a sequela (previously known as a late effect). The conditions found in Chapter 19 of the codebook are Injury, Poisoning, and Certain Other Consequences

Don't forget the 7th character when assigning Chapter 19

Remember: Guideline 19 applies to the proper use of the ICD-10 codes in every setting, including outpatient practices. Outpatient coders are not responsible for final diagnosis validation — that is a crucial clinical responsibility.

ICD-10 Guideline 19: A Conundrum for Coders - AAPC ...

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There are 490 new, 47 revised, and 58 deleted ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes finalized for fiscal 2021 taking effect October 1, 2020. The final rule includes hundreds of new ICD-10-CM codes: 128 additions to Chapter 19: Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes for adverse effects and poisoning by fentanyl and tramadol as well as other synthetic narcotics.
