Meet minimum experience requirement under the direct supervision of a licensed PE (usually 4 years) for those with an ABET-accredited Bachelor's degree in engineering. Some states require that you have a BS degree from an ABET-accredited engineering program, with no exceptions. Other states permit you to take the PE exam with an engineering technology, physics, math, or chemistry degree, or without any degree at all, providing you meet experience requirements.

## **Qualifying to Take the PE Exam | PE Exam Requirements**

To become licensed, engineers must complete a four-year college degree, work under a Professional Engineer for at least four years, pass two intensive competency exams and earn a license from their state's licensure board. Then, to retain their licenses, PEs must continually maintain and improve their skills throughout their careers.

Then, upon gaining the required experience, apply for the PE license.

## **Professional Engineer Licensure | College of Engineering ...**

Must have 12 years of progressive engineering experience of which educational study may be a part. Must be enrolled as an EI. If not a Colorado EI or transferring EI from another state, must take and pass the FE exam before being allowed to sit for the PE exam. Can apply for both FE and PE exams at the same time; however, will qualify for EI exam.

Examination Requirements. To be licensed as a professional engineer in New York State, you must pass: The Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam, and; The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam.

## **NYS Professional Engineering: License Requirements**

Also, individuals who hold a Bachelor of Science degree in engineering accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology, Inc. (ABET) and who have already taken and passed the NCEES Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Exam may take the PE Exam prior to obtaining the requisite of 4 years of satisfactory engineering experience.

## **Professional Engineers**

A Professional Engineer from an overseas Regulatory Body must first register as a Graduate Engineer to ensure that his/her basic degree satisfies the academic requirements of the Board. The applicants are required to fulfil 3 years registration as Graduate Engineer before being eligible to apply for Professional Engineer via Route 3 (Section 10(2)(d) of the Registration of Engineers Act 1967 ...
