UC San Diego has successfully tested a suicide prevention program called the Healer Education Assessment and Referral (HEAR) program. HEAR provides education about risk factors and proactive screening focused on identifying, supporting and referring clinicians for untreated depression and/or suicide risk.

Assessment processes need to be consistent across mental health services and include adequate training on how to assess, formulate, and manage suicide risk. An emphasis on patient and carer involvement is needed. In line with national guidance, risk assessment should not be seen as a way to predict future behaviour and should not be used as a means of allocating treatment.

Risk Assessment Questions. Questions should be asked in the order given until the person is no longer exhibiting the increasing risk factors. Risk level is likely to increase for suicide with the more positive and detailed responses to these questions.

The five-step plan involves identifying risk factors and protective factors, conducting a suicide inquiry, determining risk level and interventions, and documenting a treatment plan.

Suicide communication or ideation best viewed as escape behavior and treatment aims better accomplished by targeting precipitants and vulnerability factors rather than by formal risk assessment Suicide communication or ideation best viewed as operant behavior; formal risk assessment may reinforce suicide ideation
